On Saturday morning, April 1, the 32nd Annual Great Race of Agoura Hills will be off and running near or through the streets of your neighborhood. This community event raises funds for the elementary schools and high schools of Agoura Hills and Oak Park.

**YOUR HOME IS ON THE RACE ROUTE AND YOU MAY EXPERIENCE  
VEHICLE TRAFFIC DELAYS DURING PART OF THE RACE!**

Please make note of the times and routes for the six races so you can plan around the crowds. We'd love to have you show your support to the runners by making signs, playing music in your yard or out your windows and cheering on the runners in front of your house or on the course – runners love attention! Or better yet, **come on out to Chumash Park and join us as a runner, walker or spectator.** You can find out more information at our website [GreatRace.run](http://GreatRace.run). This year, runners will visit our community from 523 different zip codes and 35 states. Show your community spirit and hospitality!

If you need to leave your home, please do so with ample time before the races begin in your area. The L.A. County Sheriff's Dept. will be directing traffic and any delay should be minimized. We apologize for any inconvenience. The event has been going on for 32 years and the street closures and restrictions run smoothly. If you are traveling early that morning, you will be able to get where you need to. Plan ahead and select an alternate route away from race traffic if possible (see below and over) and allow yourself at least an extra 10-15 minutes.

The Great Race benefits the future of our community – our children! If you need to drive, please proceed cautiously and **WATCH FOR RUNNERS ON THE ROAD!** The biggest area of congestion will be around Agoura High School, Chumash Park, Kanan Rd./Thousand Oaks Blvd. intersection, Driver Ave./Chesebro Rd./Canwood St. intersection.

**Street Closures** (All times are approximate)

1. Thousand Oaks Blvd. east of Kanan Rd. will be closed from 5:15 a.m. until 11 a.m.
2. Argos St. from Thousand Oaks Blvd. to Conejo View Dr. will be closed from 6 a.m. until 12 p.m.
3. Carell Ave. at Thousand Oaks Blvd. will be closed from 5:30 a.m. until 11 a.m.
4. Idle Dr. will be closed from 5:30 a.m. until 11 a.m.
5. The intersection at Chesebro Rd./Canwood St./Driver Ave. will be closed from 6:45 a.m. until 10:30 a.m. During this time, access into and out of Old Agoura will be via Colodny Drive only. Enter via Kanan Rd. to Canwood St. to Colodny Dr. To exit from the north side of Driver Ave., head to Colodny Dr. or Fairview Pl. to Driver Ave. to Colodny Dr. to Canwood St. to Kanan Rd. To exit from the south side of Driver Ave., take Driver Ave. east to Colodny Dr. to Canwood St. to Kanan Rd.
6. Driver Ave. will be closed between Colodny Dr. and Chesebro Rd. from 6:45 a.m. until 10:30 a.m., except to residents living between those points.
7. Driver Ave. from Argos St. to Easterly Rd. will be closed from 6 a.m. to 11 a.m. Traffic will be re-routed to Conejo View Dr.
8. Avoid the Chesebro/Canwood/Palo Comado/Driver intersection. If you go this way you will experience massive delays. Instead, head to Kanan Rd. (see above for directions) for freeway access.

### **Lane Restrictions**

- Northbound traffic on Kanan Rd. will be restricted to the west lane from Thousand Oaks Blvd. to Sunnycrest Dr. Turning onto and off of Kanan Rd. will be delayed as runners pass by. The Sheriff's Dept. will be stationed at each intersection onto Kanan Rd.
- Cones will restrict traffic on Driver Ave. from to Easterly Rd. to Colodny Dr. and the Sheriff's Dept. will be directing traffic.
- Chesebro Rd. from Driver Ave. to the north end will be congested with runners from 7:10 – 8:30 a.m.
- Cones will restrict the eastbound lane of Sunnycrest Dr. from Kanan Rd. to the Rancho Simi Doubletree Trailhead entrance.
- Cones will restrict the westbound lane of Agoura Rd. from Cornell Rd. to Chesebro Rd.
- Access to the 101 Fwy from Chesebro Rd. will be restricted. Use the Kanan Rd. entrance/exit instead.

### **No Parking/Tow Away Zones** (On Saturday, April 1 from 5 a.m. – 1 p.m.)

**DO NOT PARK IN A NO PARKING/TOW AWAY ZONE.** Every year vehicles are towed from no parking zones. Pay careful attention to the posted signs to keep your vehicle out of the pound.

1. ALL of Thousand Oaks Blvd. east of Kanan Rd.
2. The east side of Kanan Rd. from Thousand Oaks Blvd. to Sunnycrest Dr.
3. Sunnycrest Dr. from Doubletree Rd. to Kanan Rd.
4. Conifer St. from Kanan Rd. to Satinwood Ave.
5. Carell Ave. from Thousand Oaks Blvd. to Hollow Brook Ave.
6. Calmfield Ave.
7. Parts of Foothill Dr.
8. Fountain Pl.
9. All streets near and surrounding Chumash Park: Driver Ave., Valley Heights Dr., Parkheath Dr., Medea Valley Dr., Agoura Glen Dr., Rock Tree Dr.
10. No parking on Argos St. from 5 a.m. Friday, March 31 – 1 p.m. Saturday, April 1
